What you should know:

Lead mid range loads preferred
Jacketed ammo allowed
Velocity of 1250fps and under
No magnum loads
Calibers up to 45ACP (NO 460,480,500, or hot loads)
No rifle shooting except 22LR

Remember if you are the last one out of the club, lock the front gate!

If you happen to catch a tagged walleye (with an external flag on its dorsal fin) the NYS DEC Lake Erie Research Unit will provide a \$100.00 reward for the return of the whole fish and its transmitter. Reward information is displayed on an the orange loop tag.
