Velocity of 1250fps and under

No magnum loads

Calibers up to 45ACP (NO 460,480,500, or hot loads)

No rifle shooting except 22LR

There will be a new drop box for range fees and a form to fill out

Remember if you are the last one out of the club, lock the front gate!
